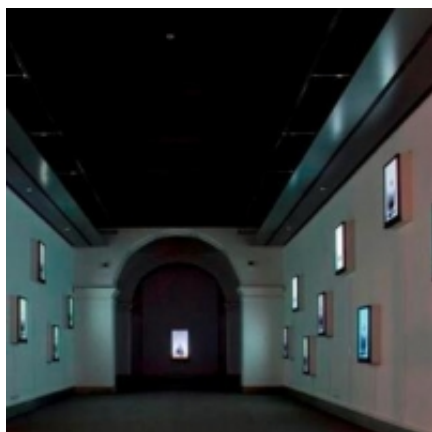

THE FIRST TECHNICAL MEETING OF THE CreArt CITIES PLACE IN VALLADOLID (SPAIN) ON SEPTEMBER 28th. THE FIRST ACTIONS AND PROPOSALS WERE EXPLAINED AND THEY WILL BE LAUNCHED SOON.

On September 28th the first technical meeting of the members of the “CreArt project. Network of Cities for Artistic Creation” took place in Valladolid to establish the details for the first actions in each city, and to decide together the European proposals that will be launched soon. Representatives from Aveiro (Portugal), Vilnius and Kaunas (Lithuania), Kristiansand (Norway), Linz (Austria), Harghita and Arad (Romania), Pardubice (Czech Republic) and London (U.K), participated in this event, together with the coordination team from Valladolid. All of them have been working in the preparation of the program since the selection of the project by the European Commission.
