The Romanian city of Arad hosted last September 27 a new CreArt seminar for cultural managers, technicians and creators about "The Art and the Research Studies on cultural policies", where case studies about European cities were discussed. In this seminar the following speakers participated: Thomas Perrin, Associate Researcher at PACTE-CNRS and University of Grenoble, Rebecca Amsellem, PhD Student in Economy of Culture at the University of La Sorbona and María Iglesias and Elisa Grafulla Project Managers in the cultural agency KEA Affairs of Brussels. At the same time, it was celebrated a work meeting in relation with the Study on the contribution of the artistic creation to the local development (cultural, social and economic) in European medium-sized cities, in which the cities from the CreArt

Network are working.



THE **ARTISTS-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAMS** FINISH IN THE CITIES OF **DELFT/THE NETHERLANDS** AND **LINZ/AUSTRIA** WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF **CreArt** EUROPEAN ARTISTS

Last September 29 it finished the Artist-in-Residence programs of **CreArt**, celebrated during the last months in the cities of Linz (Austria) and Delft (The Netherlands).

The **CreArt** AiR program in Delft has been coordinated by the Artistic Initiative id11 in the Kadmium Centre. The one in Linz has been coordinated by the Atelierhaus Salzamt Centre managed by the Linz City Hall and which is located at the banks of the Danube. In 2014 four **CreArt** cities –Kristiansand (Norway), Kaunas (Lithuania), Linz (Austria) and Delft (The Netherlands), will organize new Artist-in-Residence programs through the calls that will be announced in the **CreArt website**.

OPEN IN THE **CreArt** NETWORK OF CITIES THE CALLS FOR LOCAL ARTISTS WHO WANT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SECOND EDITION OF THE **CreArt** EUROPEAN EXHIBITION 2014.

In some of the **CreArt** cities, such as Valladolid, the local calls for selecting artists to participate in the Second Edition of the **CreArt** European Exhibition are now open. - The **CreArt** cities are already working in the research study about The contribution of the artistic creation to the cultural, social and economic development of the medium size European cities. - Coinciding with the opening of the exhibition “MORE REAL THAN THE REAL”, the **CreArt** partners will hold a meeting in Lecce to determine the details of the program of activities that the Network will develop during 2014.



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
