THE EUROPEAN EXHIBITION CreArt 2014 "WHITE NOISE, BLACK WORDS" OPENS NEXT 4 JULY IN VILNIUS (LITHUANIA)

White Noise, Black Words will open to public next 4 July in the Old Vilnius City Hall (Lithuania). During the opening, some of the 19 artists selected by the curators João Laia + Rosa Lleó with Miguel Amado will be present: Dana Stana (Arad); Patricija Gilyte y Remigijus Venckus (Kaunas); Sérgio Marques (Aveiro); Nuvola Ravera (Génova); Fülöp József (Harghita); Nina Hove (Kristiansand); Emanuela Rizzo and Sandro Marasco (Lecce); Felix Sturm, Kurt Lackner/Julio Falagán and Vildan Turalic (Linz); Kateřina Vorlová and Martin Dašek (Pardubice); Amaya Bombín y David del Bosque (Valladolid); Saulius Dastikas (Vilnius); Ana Hušman and Fokus Grupa (Zagreb).

The featured works put forward realistic depictions and dreamlike representations, rational positions and unconscious tensions, perceptible objects and ghostlike entities, primitive rituals and daily actions, conversational dynamics and intimate gestures. This eclecticism is suggested by the exhibition's title: Whereas "white noise" is commonly known as a combination of all the sounds in the human spectrum, "black words" refers to the less-visible elements of the social fabric

The exhibition will be open until 17 August and then it will travel to Zagreb (Croatia) on 1st September.

The city of Kristiansand has just selected 4 artists among more than 30 candidates to develop an artist in residence during two months in this Norwegian city.

At Kristiansand CreAir 2014 we are inspired by the great leap which the medium textile has made within the art world the last years in Norway. Kristiansand has had several strong personalities within both the textile art and the textile craft tradition. This presence of great traditions has made us aware of the unknown possibilities within the medium of textile, also for the new generation of artists.

18 CreArt ARTISTS PARTICIPATE THIS SUMMER IN ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAMMES IN LINZ (AUSTRIA), KAUNAS (LITHUANIA) AND DELFT (NETHERLANDS).

During this summer CreArt organizes 3 artists residencies that will have the participation of 18 from different cities of the network. At the end of July Patricija Gilyte (Kaunas-LT), Jan Zdvorak (Pardubice-CZ), Marit Roland (Kristiansand-NO) and Katerina Drzkova (Pardubice-CZ) end their residence at Atelierhaus Salzamt with a presentation of final work opening their studios to public. In the meantime in Kaunas, other 6 artists will enjoy their AiR: Melita Matovic Fliger (Zagreb-HR), Enrico Ingenito (Delft-NL), Alice Caracciolo (Lecce-IT), Petter Solberg (Kristiansand-NO), Adrian Rata (Arad-RO) and Francisco Manuel Mota (Aveiro-PT)

At last, in Delft the following artists will develop their residence within the frame of the multidisciplinary festival Car Art: Dina Rončević (Zagreb-HR), Fernando Guijar (Valladolid), Bartis Elemer Marton (Harghita-RO), Carlos Sanz Aldea (Valladolid), Roberta Menechini (Genoa-IT), Eddy Kaijser (Netherlands), André Vieira (Aveiro-PT) and Martina Kartelo (Zagreb-HR).
