CreArt will organize next 21 November, in the Palazzo Turrisi of Lecce (Italy) the Cultural Conference "New ways to manage and finance creative spaces in Europe". In the conference will participate European experts as Laure Kaltenbach (in the photo), Manager Director of the cultural Think Tank Forum d'Avignon (France), Hort Hörtnner, Director of Ars Electronica Futurelab in Linz (Austria) or Isabelle de Voldere, expert in competitiveness and innovaton at IDEA Consult, based in Bruxelles (Belgium).

The members of the **CreArt** Network have just selected the Austrian curator Lucas Cuturi, as next European curator for the **CreArt** 3rd European Exhibition, that will be exhibited in Pardubice (Czech republic), Linz (Austria) and Genoa (Italy) from July 2015.

Lucas Cuturi (Linz, 1973), graduated in Art History by the University of Vienna in 2009. Previously he got degree in Photography and worked as freelance photographer in

NEW OPEN CALL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAMME IN ATELIERHAUS SALZAMT OF LINZ (AUSTRIA) BETWEEN MAY AND AUGUST 2015. DEADLINE TO APPLY WILL FINISH ON 18 NOVEMBER.

CreArt has opened Open Call to participate in the Artist in Residence programme for 2015 coordinated by Atelierhaus Salzamt in Linz (Austria). Local artists from the CreArt cities will have the opportunity to spend two months in this artist residency space run by the City of Linz, centrally located on the Danube, in two periods: May–June and July–August for 4 artists each one. CreArt will cover trip costs to artists (up to 600 €), accommodation and study are free, and artists will receive 1.000 €/month as subsistence costs.
